Background to Notice of Motion:

This request is consistent with the current Reserve Management Plan and reflects the majority of views and preferences received by council from submitters across two rounds of significant consultation.

Establishing barriers to protect the poplars is consistent with the District Plan.

The replacement resolution is a reasonable and practical option for council to undertake.

The decision made in council on the 13th of December requires amendments to the Reserve Management Plan. The paper presented to council on the 13th December did not identify what these "consequential" amendments are likely to be and is therefore inconsistent with council being able to make a fully informed decision on the closure. Given the significant consultation already undertaken and public support for the reserve not to be closed we believe the decision to close should not have been made without further understanding of these amendments.

The council is also not currently in a position to be able to comment on what the impact will be for residents nor identify adequately safety concerns relating to changes to parking and vehicular movements as a result of this closure of the reserve. This makes the resolution on the 13th of Dec inconsistent with elected officials' obligations under the Health and Safety Act as a PCUB.
