Subject: EV Charging Station for Taupo

We are very pleased to be selected as the preferred provider to Taupo for EV charging solution.

We note the location offered by the Council differs from the one ChargeNet initially proposed. While the offered, centrally located, spaces seem very attractive, the location appears to be in an area of high demand and it will be difficult to provide power to the site. After discussions with Unison regarding cost of installation and prospective financial returns we must respectfully decline the offer.

Pursuant to our partnership agreement and working arrangement with Unison we request that you offer the site to Unison instead. We understand that they may elect to move ahead with the location as offered but would likely suggest another more easily serviced central location.

In the short term ChargeNet is in discussions with Z Energy to facilitate charging facility on the SH1 / SH5 junction at the recently constructed fuel station there and also in Turangi which we understand falls within the Taupo District Council area.

ChargeNet remains committed to Taupo as a high profile EV charging location and we look forward to discussing other opportunities with Council.
