Staff assisted with preparation for the junior triathlon held from Te Kapua Park on 25<sup>th</sup> March and the polocrosse event at Turangitukua Park on the weekend of 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> April. On that note, there has recently been some damage caused by 4 wheel drive vehicles crossing Turangitukua Park so staff have been repairing fences and re-siting rocks to try and prevent access. A surveillance camera will be sited there when available and police have been notified of the ongoing issues.

It is the time of year for wasps to flourish, especially around areas with willow trees. Staff have been busy poisoning over a dozen nests in the last couple of weeks, some with multiple entrances.
