

## 72 Lake Tce

I wish under Standing Orders 26.1 to submit the following motion for the extraordinary meeting set down for the 16 May 2017

" That the Taupo District Council delays the departure of staff from the building known as 72 Lake Tce until a qualified asbestos air monitoring company can be employed to ascertain asbestos levels within said building "

Background: I have expressed in the past my concern that no air monitoring of our building has been carried out. Air monitoring is the only way to see if a building is a safe working environment. As one of the companies that carried out the tests on the building said and I quote "The only way to know that there is no asbestos risk is to conduct air monitoring." end quote. I would have thought this would have been done as a matter of course.

We have gone out for consultation asking for submissions on a new build present site, a do up present site or a greenfield site. If after consultation we decide a green field site, Spa Road area has been mentioned, and if 72 Lake Tce, after air monitoring, is shown to be a safe work environment Council can continue as normal until a new build is finished saving on the costs of a early move out.
