#### 4.1 DRAFT 2017 FREEDOM CAMPING BYLAW HEARINGS REPORT

#### PURPOSE

For Council to receive the submissions for the draft 2017 Freedom Camping Bylaw and provide an opportunity for submitters who wish to be heard in support of their submissions to address the Council.

#### EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Council resolved at the 14 September 2017 meeting (**TDC201709/02**) that the draft bylaw is the most appropriate method for managing the issues associated with freedom camping and that the draft bylaw be adopted for public consultation. Council is responsible for enhancing the safety of the community and minimising the incidences of public disturbance, and bylaws provide a mechanism to achieve this.

The public consultation period ended 20 October 2017 and 49 submissions were received.

Council received 5 late submissions and it is recommended that these be accepted.

It is recommended that the submissions on the draft 2017 Freedom Camping Bylaw be received and that the submitters be thanked.
