The Turangi Toy Library have finalised their incorporated society status for their organisation and the lease documents have drawn up. However, there are still some items that need to be removed from the required space which should be done within the next week or two.
4.4	13/02/2018	Presentation: Proposal to undertake minor enhancements in the Turangi town mall playground vicinity	Mr Marnoch proposed enhancements included (1) Repairing under verandas and lighting (2) Adding more greenery, painting garden surrounds and town mall fences (3) Installing business directory type maps at main entrance points (4) Addressing downpipes / water overflow issues. Council support was sought with the supply of tools and materials eg paint, LED lights, electrical cable, plants, etc; obtaining any Council permissions / consents that may be required; and assistance from the local parks and reserves team to help put in the plants.	The Facilities Manager advised that as the shop buildings are privately owned, Council is unable to undertake any work on the under verandas and/or downpipes as the potential transfer of liability risk to Council is too high. Based on the exterior, it also appears that the buildings will require further work in addition to the verandas and downpipes, which is also the owners responsibility to attend to. Council can assist with the provision of ancillary items such as paint, plants, etc and labour. Currently, there is no available budget for the commission of town maps however, a submission for these can be included in the LTP.
