The Taupo District Council Liquor Control Bylaw (2013) is expected to be reviewed over 2018. As part of that review, consideration will be given to the appropriateness of a permanent liquor ban in the Turangi town centre. Evidence of issues and disorder related to alcohol will be required to support any future ban. It is anticipated that both the Community Board and the police will be engaged as part of the bylaw review process. The transportation team were arranging bike signage.
