- Building Services (pages 5-7):  
The Board requests that Council investigate options for a rebate type scheme, or reduced / full waiver of administrative type fees, e.g. Building Warrant of Fitness – annual, for community volunteer type groups and not-for-profit organisations.
- Environmental Health (pages 11-12):  
The Board requests that Council investigate options for a rebate type scheme or, reduced / full waiver of administrative type fees, e.g. Certificates of Registrations, for financially vulnerable traders.
