**TE TAKE MŌ TE PŪRONGO****PURPOSE**

To present the draft Speed Management Plan and the Consultation document during the consultation which closes on 13 May 2022.

**NGĀ KORERORERO****DISCUSSION**

We want everyone who calls Taupō District home and visitors who pass through to be safe when using our streets and roads. That means we need the right speeds on the right roads for all road users, whether you are walking to the shops, biking to school, driving to work or making deliveries.

The government has identified speed management as a key priority to address road safety across the country through the Road to Zero strategy. Taupō District Council is responsible for setting speed limits on roads under its control to ensure they are safe and appropriate. We are working with Waka Kotahi (the New Zealand Transport Agency) to introduce a Speed Management Plan for the roads across our District.

In 2021 it was indicated to the Tūrangi/Tongariro Community Board that Council had begun the process of creating a Speed Management Plan to review speed limits and to make our roads safer for all users. Since then, a draft plan has been developed.

The draft Speed Management Plan is now out for consultation which began on 14 March 2022.
