#### **PURPOSE**

For Council to receive the submissions for the draft Freedom Camping Bylaw and provide an opportunity for submitters who wish to be heard in support of their submissions to address the Council.

#### **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

Council resolved at the 7 February 2017 meeting (**TDC201702/09**) that the draft bylaw is the most appropriate method for managing the issues associated with freedom camping and that the draft bylaw be adopted for public consultation. Council is responsible for enhancing the safety of the community and minimising the incidences of public disturbance, and bylaws provide a mechanism to achieve this.

The public consultation period ended 18 April 2017 and 129 submissions were received.
