DISCUSSION

Important events

- 19 November 2018: Transpower and Unison power outage 10 hours within the Taupō CBD and a large portion of the district without power. The EOC was setup and operating from 9.00am. We were in contact with the hospital, Police and checking regularly with pensioners around the district. We were in contact with the supermarkets to ensure that they had supplies of diesel to run their generators so they were able to operate to usual capacity.
- 22 & 23 November 2018: Exercise Gumboot 22 staff members travelled to Waiouru Military Base to participate in a table top exercise based on a landslide.
- 29 November 2018: 2 unimogs were collected from Trentham Military base. This was greatly appreciated and was made available through Maj. Pat Hibbs.
- 12 December 2018 Physical Hipaua Thermal Cliffs survey was completed. The formal report should be completed in February 2019.

- 21 November 2018: Community preparedness presentation at Taupō Baptist Church.
- 1 December 2018: Taupō Christmas Parade.
- 15 December 2018: Turangi Christmas Parade and Christmas in the Park.
