Ongoing enhancement involves clearing of gorse/blackberry and replanting with native trees/shrubs plus resurfacing of the trail to make it safer and "all weather proof".

Currently long lengths of the trail have exposed tree roots and a surface which becomes slippery and muddy in wet weather. These pose a safety risk to users.

The bulk of the maintenance and enhancement of the Trail is carried out by local KCA volunteer members. Recently the KCA invested in a industrial scale mower to keep the Trail tidy. Costs associated with this activity is funded by the KCA.

Funding is sort for Year 1 to:

Upgrade the Trail surface with locally sourced Rock/Ash which is the material used and recommended by DoC and Bike Taupo as the best solution. (Note: there is only one supplier locally, Seay Earthmovers) hence we can only get one quotation for supply.)

Shape and compact the Rock/Ash by Bike Taupo's experienced contractor (McFarlane Contracting) who is experienced in shaping trails suitable for walking and biking. One quote as McFarlane come highly recommended as experience in this work.

Purchase 1000 shrubs (including fertiliser and stakes/protectors) for planting in newly cleared areas of the trail. Our preferred supplier is Treeline Native Nursery as we have had previous satisfactory quality from them.



We are a non-profit community run playgroup that relies heavily on fundraising, donations, grants, casual attendance and membership fees to cover our operational and maintenance costs during the year. We have been hit pretty hard by the financial backlash of Covid and have had a drop in member numbers only being able to cover operational costs during the last few months. Now that we are the orange traffic light phase of the Covid protection frame work we are seeing more and more families come through our doors and our member numbers are starting to climb. In the meantime, the surface of our deck which is our main entrance has become worse for wear and is losing its non-slip factor.

For health and safety reasons we want to remedy this as soon as possible. So that we can provide a safe area for parents, caregivers and our wee ones to walk on without the fear of slipping especially parents with baby in their arms. Our deck is multipurpose area utilized both in summer and winter, so we have the issue of it being icy in winter and wet in summer with the amount of waterplay that the children engage in over the summer months. Having the non-skid deck grit paint on it over the years has prevent many an accident from occurring.

We have a sheltered area on our deck where the clearlite has become brittle and cracked, Now when it rains it leaks onto our seated area which is also used to storage prams, buggys and shoes to keep these out of the way of the door during a busy playgroup sessions. This seat area provides much needed protection from the elements during all seasons of the year.

On page 57 the council outlines the benefits of council run community facilities being that "these facilities help to provide for the physical and mental well-being of everyone who spends time in the district"

The committee of Taupo Community Playgroup believe that we provide a service to the community that also looks after mothers mental well-being by providing a safe haven for mums/dads and caregivers of babies/children with in our community that will allow them to grow their support networks and join a team of mums and dads dedicated to providing a safe and nurturing space for our children to run and grow and make life long friends. Members of the community that attend playgroup have the opportunity to continue to attend playgroup until their children are school age.

We have a variety of indoor and outdoor spaces that are utilized during our sessions, one being our large deck area that also doubles as our entry into our building. This space is a multi use space that during this pandemic has provided our playgroup community with a well ventilated space to engage in many activites such as waterplay, outdoor painting and pinics on the deck. We would love to continue to use this space throughout the year and even host a few coffee groups out here during the warmer weather. Still providing an area where adults can come together and chat while engaging in play with their little ones.

Also on page 57 the council states that " Social well-being: our residents may not be able to provide for their mental and physical well-being if our facilities do not

meet the needs of our communities".

The committee of Taupo Community Playgroup believe that we are meeting the needs of our community by providing a facility where mothers/fathers/caregivers can come together with their children and engage in play with their children and others whilst getting the social support that is required mentally from adults that may be going through or gone through similar life situations.

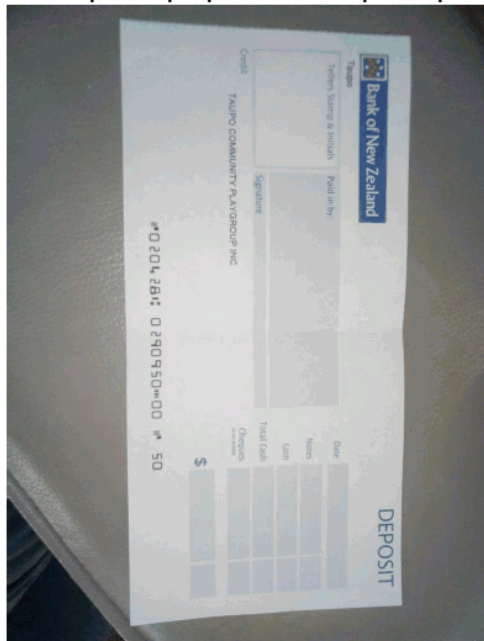

Each week, we provide transport for young people from outside both Mountview school and Taupo Intermediate, provide kai, and facilitate activities such as games, cooking, and growing food in the small Youthtown garden for the rangatahi and their whanau. We also encourage rangatahi to
