5.7 TAUPŌ DISTRICT COUNCIL PERFORMANCE REPORT - JULY 2024

The Chief Executive updated Council to advise that Te Kapua Papa Tākaro had been awarded a highly commended award at the recent Local Government New Zealand awards.

The Project Management Office Manager highlighted some key updates in the Portfolio Update attached to the agenda. She advised that she would provide an update on the SCADA upgrade project at the Council meeting the following month.

The Infrastructure Project Manager – Operations gave a detailed update on the Taupō Wastewater Southern Trunk Main Upgrade Stage 1 project. He advised that the contractor had installed 3 kilometres and another 2.2 kilometres remained. Work was currently underway around Tremaine Avenue and Shepherd Road and involved a special pipe due to the geothermal area. Traffic cones near 2 Mile Bay Sailing Centre would be removed in the following weeks once holes were filled. The project was on track to be completed by early December 2024. The Infrastructure Project Manager – Operations confirmed that the pipes were made in Auckland, although the specialist pipe for the geothermal areas that could handle temperatures up to 90 degrees Celsius were from Italy.

The General Manager Organisation Performance advised that regular meetings were being held with auditors to mitigate any risks of not being able to adopt the Long-term Plan 2024-34 on 30 September 2024. Council shared concerns with the sector as to the high cost of auditors.
