At the Turangi/Tongariro Community Board meeting held on Tuesday, May 14, 2019, senior policy advisor Hadley Tattle presented a report on the Taupō District Council Draft Fees and Charges 2019-2020 and invited the members to make a submission. Accordingly, we thank you for this opportunity to submit and respectfully make the following comments for consideration and where practicable, inclusion in the final adopted Fees and Charges 2019-20:

- Building Services (pages 5-7):
   The Board requests that Council investigate options for a rebate type scheme, or reduced / full waiver of administrative type fees, e.g. Building Warrant of Fitness annual, for community volunteer type groups and not-for-profit organisations.
- Environmental Health (pages 11-12):
   The Board requests that Council investigate options for a rebate type scheme or, reduced / full waiver of administrative type fees, e.g. Certificates of Registrations, for financially vulnerable traders.

The Board would like to speak to this submission at the May 27 hearings.
